Lakehouse was selected as preferred contractor to undertake the phased internal refurbishment of Greenwich’s Shooters Hill Post 16 Campus, which offers an adult learning environment, encouraging independence and self-reliance.

Greenwich Council obtained funding from the Learning and Skills Council to remodel the existing buildings on the former Eaglesfield School site, to provide the new post 16 Campus for 1000 pupils. The newly remodelled buildings contain 7200sqm of internal space including; a new main entrance; 36 teaching rooms, cyber cafe, hair and beauty salons, and catering kitchen.

The campus remained fully occupied and work was carried out to tight timescales and to a high quality standard. The client was so impressed with the state-of-the-art facilities Lakehouse created, that further phases were negotiated with the London Borough of Greenwich.

The campus successfully attracts a diverse student body, who enjoy the excellent facilities, including a multi-functional facility and Learning Resource Centre. These developments are helping the Campus to address local needs for vocational routes that can lead to apprenticeships and employment.
