REFURBISHMENT OF MEDWAY CAMPUS

Works at Grade II listed Pembroke building, part of the Medway Campus, in Chatham, included the refurbishment of the wardroom to the first floor and cafeteria/social areas on the ground floor.

Existing floor finishes were removed and the entire wardroom was redecorated. The walls are lined with hardwood panels, covered with ornate carved figures and the central feature is wood grained with a coat of arms decorated in gold. Particular care was taken to ensure that these elements were properly restored and special access equipment was required to enable the safe decoration of the high level vaulted roof trusses.

New mechanical and electrical services were installed to the cafeteria/social areas together with ceramic wall and floor tiles, vinyl flooring, suspended ceilings, fire shutter, hardwood wall paneling and kitchen servery equipment. A lift pit, lift shaft and lift were installed to provide easy access to the first floor. The ceiling in the canteen area has a recessed central area in the shape of a 'rugby ball' where concealed lighting has been fitted; the light system enables a variety of colour changes to produce a number of different effects.
