As a named framework contractor for the Improved Efficiency South East (IESE) Tier 3 Framework, Lakehouse secured its first project at Fort Hill Community School. Work was undertaken from its regional office in Salisbury and included the fit-out of a science preparation area and the demolition of three existing classrooms and a communal area to make way for two larger classrooms.

The science preparation classroom is vital to the school and enables teachers to prepare equipment and materials for science lessons. The room was completely stripped out and refitted with high quality storage areas, wash down areas, new

work surfaces and fire protection to the roof area. Lakehouse was delighted to offer an alternative fire protection system which produced both cost and time savings for Hampshire County Council.

Work was carried out during the summer holiday period and completed two weeks ahead of programme, enabling staff and students to return to fantastic new facilities with no disruption whatsoever. The project was a complete success from start to finish, with the client commenting that overall project performance was excellent.
