The refurbishment of Burridge Village Hall was undertaken by Lakehouse’s south west regional office, and officially opened by the Executive Leader of Fareham Borough Council, Councillor Sean Woodward on 19 July 2008.

In 2007, following a public consultation, the Council’s Executive approved funding to refurbish the former dilapidated facility, including sports changing rooms and car park. The hall, built in the 1960’s had deteriorated and was under used but the refurbishment has given the hall a new lease of life and it

is now being regularly used for mother and toddler groups, aerobics, line dancing, and meditation classes.

Executive Leader of Fareham Borough Council, Councillor Sean Woodward, said *“It is always nice to be able to put ‘new life’ into an old and under used community building.
