The challenge of limited drawings and a continually evolving scope of works was overcome by a programme of weekly 'walk arounds' which provided regular opportunities to

highlight issues with design and ensure that nothing was overlooked. We were able to make considerable cost savings for the client by recommending alternative supply chain partners. Additional cost savings were achieved as a result of advice that we were able to provide on a range of alternative fire testing systems. The school is now compliant with the latest fire safety legislation and the room relocation works have enabled access to all areas for disabled pupils.
