The refurbishment of Burridge Village Hall was undertaken by Lakehouse's south west regional office, and officially opened by the Executive Leader of Fareham Borough Council, Councillor Sean Woodward on Saturday 19 July 2008.

In 2007, following a public consultation, the Council's Executive approved funding to refurbish the former dilapidated facility, including sports changing rooms and car park. The hall, built in the 1960's had deteriorated and was under used but the refurbishment has given the hall a new lease of life and it is now being regularly used for aerobics, line dancing, meditation classes and mother & toddler groups.

Executive Leader of Fareham Borough Council, Councillor Sean Woodward, said "It is always nice to be able to put 'new life' into an old and under used community building. A lot of hard work has been put in to the refurbishment of Burridge Village Hall and I'm delighted to see that it is now a popular community facility."

Pat Johnson of the Burridge Community Association, commented "The hall is looking really great and is starting to be used exactly as it was meant to be, as a facility for the local residents and the Borough."
