Lakehouse's work at Moberly Sports & Education Centre involved the removal of defective ground floor concrete slab and installation of a pre cast beam and block ground floor to the entire sports hall. Work included careful removal of retractable seating and existing lockers which had to be reinstated once the new floor had been completed.

Upon removal of the existing concrete floor and subsequent excavations, often in a confined working space, foundations from a previous development were discovered. Despite the challenge that this presented, Lakehouse was able to complete the project on time and on budget, installing high quality, durable Pulastic 2000 polyurethane seamless flooring. The product's key features are its resilience and versatility but most importantly for the centre, its suitability for heavy duty usage and its ability to accept chair legs, shoe heels and retractable seating without fear of damage.

The centre was thoroughly cleaned to ensure that it was free from dust, dirt, grime and other contaminants before undertaking a complete internal redecoration and the application of court markings.
